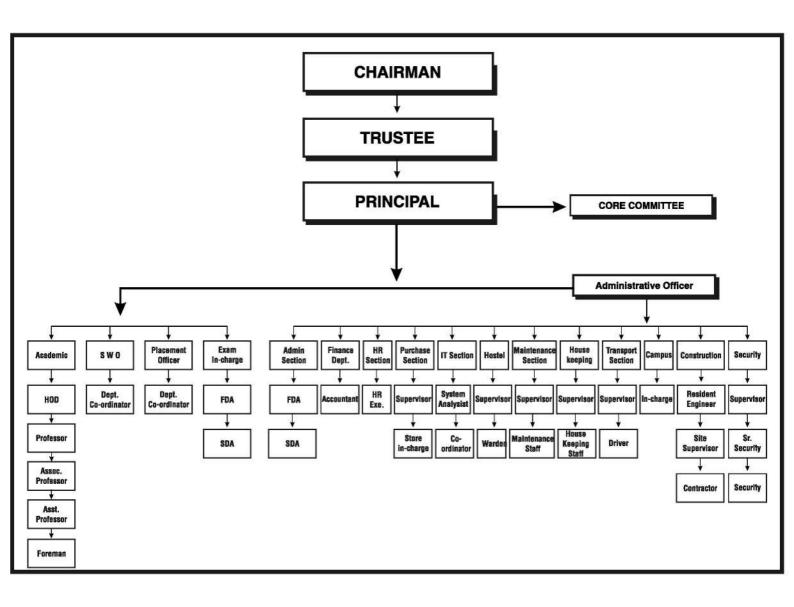

#### Objectives of the GRC

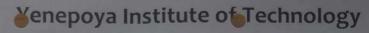

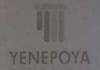
