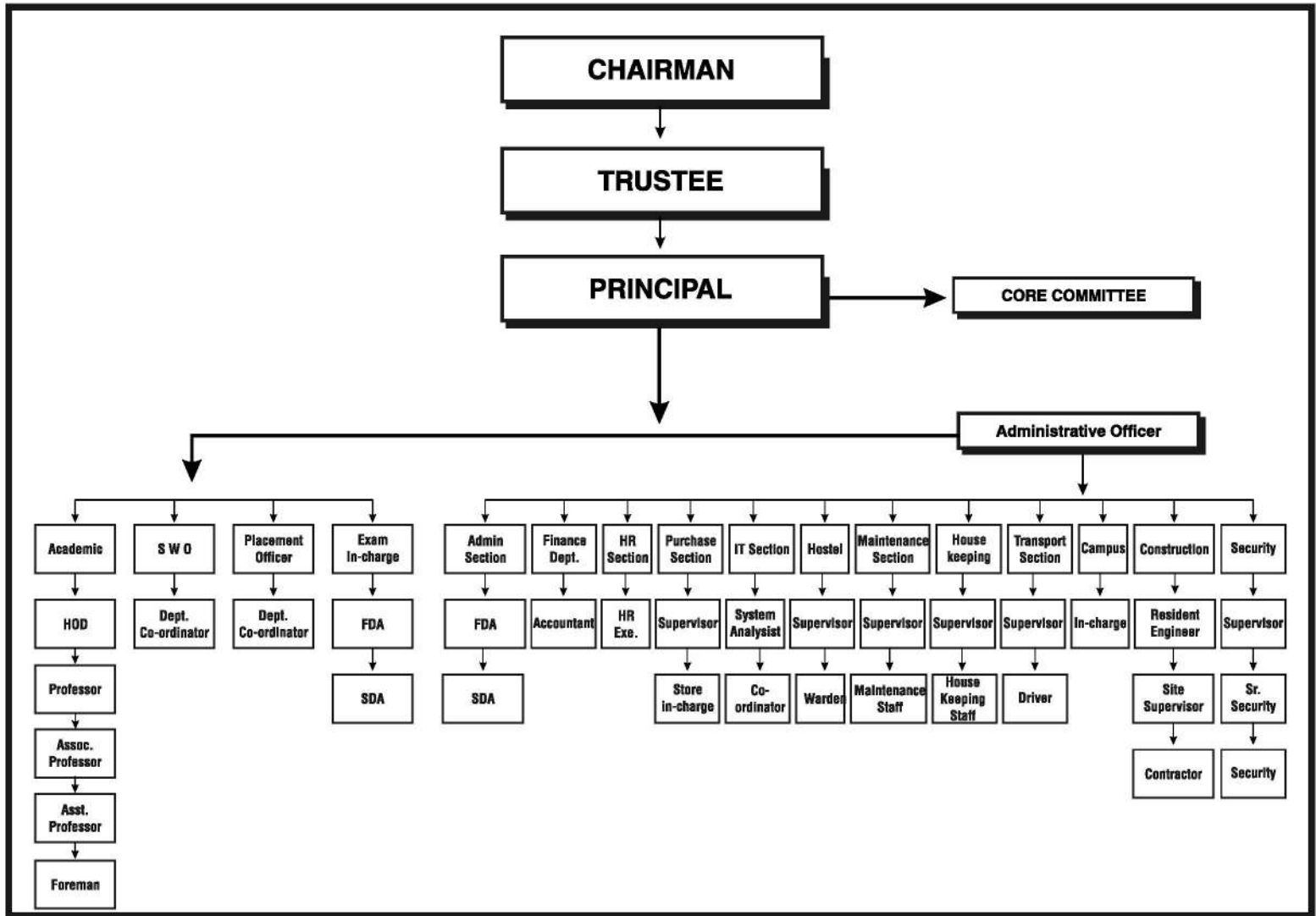

Objectives of the GRC

1. It is to deal with the complex situations in a tactful manner to lessen the condition felt to be oppressive or dissatisfied.
2. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in and outside the institution. Any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules should be urgently brought to the notice of the Principal.
3. Encouraging the Staff and Students to express their grievances / problems freely and frankly, without any fear.
4. Advising all staff to be affectionate to the Students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason

SCOPE of the GRC

The cell will deal with Grievances received in writing from the students about any of the following matters

1. **Academic Matters:** Related to timely issue of duplicate Mark-sheets, Transfer Certificates, Conduct Certificates or other examination related matters.
2. **Financial matters:** Related to dues and payments for various items from tuition fees, hostel fee etc.
3. **Other Matters:** Related to certain misgivings about conditions of sanitation, preparation of food, availability of transport, victimization by teachers etc.

Functions of GRC

1. The cases will be attended promptly on receipt of written grievances from the students and staff.
2. The cell formally will review all cases and will act accordingly as per the Management policy.
3. The cell will give report to the authority about the cases attended to and the number of pending cases, if any, which require direction and guidance from the higher authorities.


Procedure for Lodging Complaint

1. The staff and students may feel free to put up a grievance through Register/Suggestion box or college portal info@yit.edu.in provided.
2. The Grievance Cell will act upon those cases which have been forwarded along with the necessary documents.
3. The Grievance Cell will assure that the grievance has been properly solved in a stipulated time limit provided by the cell.
